SHORT TITLE: Study Biochar in Wildfire Mitigation Efforts

LONG TITLE: Concerning a comprehensive study on biochar, and, in connection therewith, studying the use of biochar in wildfire mitigation efforts.

SPONSORS: Sen. Cutter/Representatives Will and Velasco

COMMITTEES: Senate Agriculture & Natural Resources Committee

PURPOSE OF THE BILL: To study the properties and use of biochar for wildfire mitigation

PROPONENTS OF THE BILL: Wildfire Matters Review Committee

POTENTIAL STAKEHOLDERS: water groups, conservation organizations

BACKGROUND: For several years, advocates for biochar have urged its use as a soil amendment, to aid in soil retention of water

Is this bill necessary this year? There is no deadline

How does the bill change current law? It directs Colorado State University to conduct or cause to be conducted a study on biochar and establishes parameters to be studied, with a report back to the Wildfire Review committee in 2026.

Does the bill affect the prior appropriations system? No

How is the bill implemented?

Practical considerations:

Fiscal Impact. No money is appropriated and there is no fiscal note.
